R-22 IS GOING AWAY

Service practices of the past likely to result in supply shortage of R-22 in the future.

December 15th, 2009, the US EPA Administrator signed the final rule for future HCFC allowances. Unexpectedly, the annual supply of R-22 was reduced every year versus staying flat. **Why is this important?** This unexpected change creates a supply/demand imbalance of 27.5 million pounds for the workhorse refrigerant R-22 every year from 2010 - 2015. The future price of R-22 is likely to be volatile.

DuPont Refrigerants has been preparing for this change by developing unique ISCEON refrigerants which combine similar R-22 pressure enthalpy characteristics with mineral oil compatibility. These features have provided contractors a Quick Switch to retrofit away from R-22.

DuPont Refrigerant will be presenting a class here at *USAirConditioning* to explain the details of the recent changes in the HCFC allowance rule, the impact on HVACR contractors and technical details of the R-22 replacements refrigerants.
